GET FAMILIAR WITH THE NEW 96 DECIBEL SOUND LIMIT



A new Montana sound law (MCA 61-9-418) begins October 1, 2007, which requires 96 dBA (decibel) sound limit* and U.S.F.S. approved spark arrestor.

*Testing is done using procedures established by the Society of Automotive Engineers under the Standard J-1287.
